

**NWR JUNIOR TIME TRIAL

**EMERGENCY PROCEDURE**

In the event of any accident requiring the attendance of the ambulance service the following procedure must be adopted:

1. Call for the nearest safety boat to carry out the rescue if on the water.
2. Notify the clubhouse by radio or telephone (01606 49461) that an ambulance is needed.
3. Tell the clubhouse to which landing point the injured person/s is/are being taken.
4. The radio holder at the clubhouse will telephone for an ambulance.
5. A mobile phone holder at the start or at the Blue Bridge may also call for an ambulance if it is deemed more expedient.
6. In either case the same routine for phoning the ambulance service must be adopted as follows:

**Dial 999 and ask for the ambulance service.**

**Tell them that Northwich Rowing Club needs an ambulance at Access Point A, B, C or D on the River Weaver and state the reason for that need.**

The access points are:

| <b>Access point A (WW29)</b> | The fisherman's car park at the railway viaduct.                               |
| <b>Access point B (WW27)</b> | The entrance to the fisherman's car park at Hartford Bridge (the Blue Bridge). |
| <b>Access point C (WW25)</b> | The fisherman's car park off Monarch Drive, Kingsmead.                         |
| <b>Access point D (WW23)</b> | The Rowing Club, off The Crescent.   |

**This procedure has been agreed with the Emergency Services and must be followed. WW—is the Waterways Watch reference used by Cheshire Constabulary and British Waterways to identify the location to the Ambulance Service.**
